Through its [programme for Longitudinal Studies](#), the SNSF supports a number of large cohorts in different disciplines (Swiss HIV Cohort, Swiss Hepatitis C Cohort, Swiss Transplant Cohort, SAPALDIA, PsyCoLaus, C-SURF, Swiss National Cohort, Swiss IBD Cohort, Swiss Atrial Fibrillation Cohort). Other cohorts and registries in Switzerland, although not directly funded as infrastructures by the SNSF, are the basis for research projects submitted to the project funding schemes of the SNSF. The SNSF has a broad overview on these and collaborates with their stakeholders.

The SNSF is currently aiming to achieve a better integration and harmonisation of the Swiss cohorts on a national and international level to make best use of this invaluable data sets. This by developing best practices to optimise data and know-how access in the context of the Swiss personalized health network and according to the SNSF's open research data policy.
